A number of our guests and several of our vendors have been here with us every year as the Printers Fair grew from its small beginnings in 2009. Others continue to discover the wonders of printing and the books arts for the first time. Enjoy your experience, support the artists you see today, and then tell others about the Printing Museum so that we don't remain the "greatest hidden wonder" of Los Angeles!






ITINERANT PRINTER EXHIBITION

Book artist Chris Fritton of NY set out on an ambitious cross-country journey, visiting letterpress shops in the 48 states. His project "The Itinerant Printer", produced unique prints at each of the more than 200 venues, culled from their idiosyncratic collections of antique wood type, metal type, cuts, ornaments, and photopolymer plates.
