LOS SINGELES PRINTERS FAIR

The 14th annual Los Angeles Printers Fair at the International Printing Museum is here! The largest Celebration of Letterpress, Printing & the Book Arts in the country, where printing artists come together and share their work. The Printers Fair is a rare opportunity to meet these book artists and letterpress printers who are part of the creative movement known as Book Arts, artists who use traditional machines and processes with a decidedly modern twist, many of whom work in small studios and garages. The backdrop for the Fair is the fabulous Ernest A. Lindner Collection of working antique printing presses.

The last three years have seen tremendous growth for the Printing Museum with improvements in our galleries, significant acquisitions such as the David Peat Typographic Collection and the Smithsonian Morgan/Linotype/ATF Type Collection (both of which will be featured at next year's Printers Fair).

We have also received significant funding and support from several foundations and patrons (The Windgate Foundation, the Ludwick Family Foundation, the Miki Young Charitable Foundation, and the John & Robyn Horn Foundation); their support has allowed us to develop our Book Arts Institute, housed in the rear building. The Windgate Foundation also established the beginning of our endowment with a \$3 million endowment, insuring the Printing Museum mission into the future.

We have also continued our involvement with Hollywood through rentals of the collection for films and shows. Most significantly is providing a full 19th century newspaper printing shop for THE GILDED AGE, a series on HBO created by Downton Abbey's Julian Fellows. Our Prouty Grasshopper Newspaper Press in the Country Shop in the Museum's front gallery takes center stage for two season's on the series, bringing to life the first black-owned newspaper, The Globe in NY. Look for some special props and created newspapers on the museum set.

A very big thank you to our lead sponsors: the Printing Industries Association (PIASC) and Kelly Spicers Paper. And of course, a very big thank you to our many dedicated volunteers, who are the heart and soul of the Printing Museum. Those volunteers make the magic happen over and over again!







The International Printing Museum features the Lindner Collection, the world's largest gathering of antique printing presses, such as the iconic Albion Press from England pictured here. This year marks the 200th anniversary of this iron hand press that could be seen in literally every British printing shop around the world.



The Museum's galleries are filled with the machines and tools of the graphic arts industry from historic Chinese printing blocks to the cast-iron newspaper presses of the 19th century. Marvel at the clattering sounds of the 1890 Linotype that changed the world and enjoy the stories of Ben Franklin and how books and printing shaped his life.
